

## SPAIN - STUDENT VISA APPLICATION CHECKLIST - MIAMI CONSULATE

To apply for a visa you must appear in person **no** earlier than 90 days from your departure date.

Appointments are not required to submit your application. Applications are accepted Monday through Friday 8:30am to 11:30am. We suggest you arrive early in the morning to submit your application.

- A Money Order payable to the Consulate General of Spain will need to be included with your application. US Citizens will pay \$160.00. For all others please the Consulate's website.
- 2 National Visa Applications (Original AND Photocopy) Print do not use Cursive. The Consulate will render applications with whiteout, crossed out or written over answers invalid. If you make a mistake while filling it out, you must print out a new application.
- 2 color photos with a white background (passport type) glued to the applications.
- **Original Passport** (plus photocopy) valid for a minimum of 4 months after retuning from Spain. The passport must have a full blank page on which the visa can be affixed.
- Drivers License, State ID or University ID (whichever provides proof of residency in the Consulate's jurisdiction). Plus photocopy
- Recent Financial Statement. The statement must show the balance of the account showing a minimum of \$700.00 per each month of stay in Spain. If your parent submits their statement, the below letter needs to also be attached to their financial statement. Financial Aid students may instead attach an original official letter from the institution that has granted the aid, indicating the amount allocated in their name.
- Notarized Proof of Financial Means Form from parent or legal guardian assuming full financial responsibility, along with a photocopy of their ID.
- **Permit to come back to the United States**: Green Card (if not US national), Valid US student visa or work permit (stamp on the passport). Original and Copy
- Official Acceptance Letter in Spanish, Proof of Insurance Letter from GeoBlue, and SAI Enrollment Letter. (Originals and photocopies) SAI will mail these documents to your permanent address to be included with your application.
- When you receive your passport back with your visa, scan the visa page and submit it to your admissions counselor at <u>ben@saiprograms.com</u>.

It is advisable that you make a copy of your visa application materials for your personal files
