### Students applying directly to the Spanish Consulate in Miami

To apply for a visa you must appear in person **no** earlier than 90 days from your departure date.

Appointments are not required to submit your application. Applications are accepted Monday through Friday 8:30am to 1:30pm. This is on a first come first serve basis, so we suggest you arrive early in the morning to submit your application.

- **A Money Order** payable to the Consulate General of Spain will need to be included with your application. US Citizens will pay \$160.00. For all others please see the Consulate's website.
- **2 National Visa Applications Print do not use Cursive.** The Consulate will render applications with whiteout, crossed out or written over answers invalid. If you make a mistake while filling it out, you must print out a new application. (original and copy)
- **2 color photos with a white background (passport type) glued to the applications.**
- **Original Passport** (plus photocopy) valid for a minimum of 3 months after returning from Spain. The passport must have a full blank page on which the visa can be affixed.
- **Driver's License, State ID or University ID** (whichever provides proof of residency in the Consulate's jurisdiction). Plus photocopy
- **Proof of Economic Means** (Originals and Copies) The Consulate is looking for a bank statement showing a minimum bank balance of approximately \$2800 (calculated at \$700 per month while in Spain). Online printouts are not acceptable but Consulate will accept bank printout if it is stamped and signed with banker's business card attached.

If a parent is submitting this financial information, they must ALSO submit the Proof of Financial Means Form (located on our website). Their signature on this form must be notarized. The student's birth certificate must ALSO be included – this may be a notarized copy.

Financial Aid students may instead attach an original official letter from the institution that has granted the aid, indicating the amount allocated in their name.

- **Non US Citizens** Green Card, Valid US student visa. Original and copy
- **Official Acceptance Letter in Spanish, Proof of Insurance Letter, and SAI Enrollment Letter. (Originals and photocopies) SAI will mail these documents to your permanent address to be included with your application.**
- When you receive your passport back with your visa, scan the visa page and submit it to your admissions counselor.

It is advisable that you make a copy of your visa application materials for your personal files
